4. Preliminary Report on Coaching Certification
Bill Treat reported that the USSA Level 100 Coaching Course has been submitted to CIF for evaluation in the hope that high school coaches may enroll in the USSA course and meet all CIF/School District requirements for coach certification. (All coaches must be certified starting in 2008). This course would be specific for ski/board coaches rather than the generalized coach certification format used by school districts now.
5. Helmets
Jack Morgan requested that CNI SSF allow helmets with soft ears.
After discussion and consultation with the 2006-2007 FIS equipment Standards, all CNI SSF racers will adhere to the current helmet guideline which includes hard shell over the ears. (Section XV, CNI SSF Bylaws)
